1	CORONER
	I am S McGovern, Senior Coroner, for the coroner area of Coventry
2	CORONER'S LEGAL POWERS
	I make this report under paragraph 7, Schedule 5, of the Coroners and Justice Act 2009 and regulations 28 and 29 of the Coroners (Investigations) Regulations 2013.
3	INVESTIGATION and INQUEST
	I opened an investigation on 13 January 2014 into the death of Amanda Richards, late of 5 Kildare Close, Coventry. I concluded the inquest on 24 April 2014 and returned a conclusion that her death was accidental.
4	CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE DEATH
	Ms Richards suffered from Peri-ventricular Leckomalacia and was a wheelchair user. She had live-in carers 22 hours per day. On 3 rd December 2013 it seems she dropped a cigarette and died in the subsequent fire. The fire occurred while she was alone.
5	CORONER'S CONCERNS
	During the course of the inquest the evidence revealed matters giving rise to concern. In my opinion there is a risk that future deaths will occur unless action is taken. In the circumstances it is my statutory duty to report to you.
	The MATTERS OF CONCERN are as follows. —
	I heard from Fire Investigation Officer Holder that the provision of a domestic sprinkler system would have made the death far less likely. I accept that the provision of such a system throughout your housing stock would be prohibitively expensive but I ask you to consider such provision in special accommodation such as Ms Richards.
6	ACTION SHOULD BE TAKEN
	In my opinion action should be taken to prevent future deaths and I believe you have the power to take such action.
