CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims arising in respect of changes made to the Teachers Pension Scheme: Ms L Allwood & others v Secretary of State for Education & others (case No. 1807359/2019 & others)

CLAIMS in respect of changes made to the Teachers Pension Scheme having been received in various Employment Tribunal regions in England and Wales

AND those claims being variously presented by or on behalf of individual claimants

AND having considered correspondence from the parties or their representatives

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the First Schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

AND having regard to the representations made by or on behalf of the parties

AND having regard to the distribution of judicial and administrative workload and resources as between the Employment Tribunal regions

AND having regard to the listing of claims arising in Wales for a case management hearing before the Regional Employment Judge (Wales) at Cardiff on 20 March 2020

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

ALL such claims be transferred to the Employment Tribunal at the London East region (Import Building)

AND such claims are to be combined and case managed in accordance with the directions of the Regional Employment Judge and any nominated judge at London East region

AND – without prejudice to the recognition that these cases may give rise to different case management, issues and outcomes – all such claims shall be managed as appropriate in coordination between the Regional Employment Judges at London East region and London Central region (and any nominated judges) with regard to other public sector pensions multiple cases presently managed at London Central region

SAVE that the transfer of claims arising in Wales shall take account of the devolution arrangements in Wales and upon further application to the Regional Employment Judge (Wales) at Cardiff Employment Tribunal

AND any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of any such claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge at London East (and copied to any other interested party or person)
