CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims in respect of holiday pay brought against Hermes Parcelnet

CLAIMS in respect of holiday pay against Hermes Parcelnet having been received in various Employment Tribunal regions in England and Wales

AND having regard to the decision of the Employment Tribunal in *Leyland and others v Hermes Parcelnet Limited* (Case No. 1800575/2017 and others) heard between 30 April and 3 May 2018 and promulgated on 23 June 2018

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the First Schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

AND having regard to the distribution of judicial and administrative workload and resources as between the Employment Tribunal regions

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

ALL such present and future claims be transferred to the Employment Tribunal at Leeds

AND such claims are to be combined and case managed in accordance with the directions of the Regional Employment Judge at Leeds

AND any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of any such claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge at Leeds (and copied to any other interested party or person)
