CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims against Oasis Fashions Limited, Oasis & Warehouse Limited,
Warehouse Fashions Limited, The Idle Man Limited and/or Bastyan Fashions Limited
arising out of their entering Administration on 15 April 2020

CLAIMS against Oasis Fashions Limited, Oasis & Warehouse Limited, Warehouse Fashions Limited, The Idle Man Limited and/or Bastyan Fashions Limited (arising out of their entering Administration on 15 April 2020 and/or the subsequent closure of Oasis & Warehouse stores) having been received in various Employment Tribunal regions in England and Wales

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the First Schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

AND having regard to the distribution of judicial and administrative workload and resources as between the Employment Tribunal regions

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

ALL such present and future claims be transferred to the South-East England Employment Tribunal region;

AND such claims are to be combined and case managed in accordance with the directions of the Regional Employment Judge for the South-East England region, with a view to any claims being heard at the Employment Tribunal in Reading;

AND any party or representative wishing to make representations for the future conduct of any such claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge for the South-East England region, at the regional office in Watford, and copied to any other interested party or person;
