## CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

# In the matter of age discrimination claims challenging the Civil Service Compensation Scheme

CLAIMS of age discrimination challenging the redundancy and voluntary exit terms of the Civil Service Compensation Scheme having been received in various Employment Tribunal regions in England and Wales

AND having received representations dated 19 March 2020 from the Government Legal Department on behalf of the respondents to these claims

AND understanding that the claims subject to this Order have been brought by claimants who are litigants in person and who may have relied in bringing their claims upon a notice published on the website of the Public and Commercial Services Union

AND appreciating that these claimants have not yet had an opportunity to make representations

AND understanding that the respondents are likely to assert that these claims are not brought in time and that they do not plead any reason why it would be just and equitable to extend time

AND understanding that there may be other such present and future claims in which the Government Legal Department is not instructed

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the First Schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

AND having regard to the distribution of judicial and administrative workload and resources as between the Employment Tribunal regions

AND indicating that the President shall keep the matter under review

#### IT IS ORDERED THAT:

THE claims in Schedule A (claims challenging the provisions for tapering and capping voluntary redundancy or voluntary exit compensation payments in respect of employees who are approaching or have reached their normal pension age of 60 years at their last day of service), and all such future claims of a similar kind, shall be stayed and transferred to the Employment Tribunal at Bristol

AND such claims are to be combined and case managed in accordance with the directions of the Regional Employment Judge at Bristol AND that consideration be given to the claim in *Paskins v HMRC* (1400830/2020) being treated as a lead case in accordance with Rule 36

THE claims in Schedule B (claims challenging the provisions for tapering and capping compulsory redundancy compensation payments in respect of employees who are approaching or have reached their normal pension age of 60 years at their last day of service), and all such future claims of a similar kind, shall be stayed and shall be transferred to the Employment Tribunal at Manchester

AND such claims are to be combined and case managed in accordance with the directions of the Regional Employment Judge at Manchester

AND that consideration be given to the claim in *Newby v HMRC* (2400627/2020) being treated as a lead case in accordance with Rule 36

AND in respect of claims in both Schedule A and Schedule B all currently listed hearings in these claims be vacated and all current case management orders stayed subject to the Regional Employment Judges at Bristol and at Manchester convening separate case management hearings on notice to all parties to determine how best to proceed in the light of the representations of the Government Legal Department dated 19 March 2020 and any representations that might be made by individual claimants

AND the Regional Employment Judges concerned (and any nominated judge) shall seek to coordinate the case management of these claims in both Schedules

AND any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of any such claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge at Bristol or the Regional Employment Judge at Manchester as the case might be (and copied to any other interested party or person)

AND the Government Legal Department shall ensure that all claimants in either Schedule shall be served with a copy of its representations dated 19 March 2020 as soon as reasonably practicable and in advance of any future case management hearing

AND a copy of this Case Management Order shall be sent to ACAS and to all known interested parties, and shall be published on the Judiciary website at:
