CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims arising from the closure of parts of the Patisserie Valerie businesses and the administration of Patisserie Holdings Plc, Stonebeach Ltd (trading as Patisserie Valerie) and PV Holdings Realisations Ltd (formerly Patisserie Valerie Holdings Ltd)

HAVING NOTED THAT Patisserie Holdings Plc, Stonebeach Ltd (trading as Patisserie Valerie) and PV Holdings Realisations Ltd (formerly Patisserie Valerie Holdings Ltd) which operated branches of cafés and shops under the name Patisserie Valerie were put into administration on various dates

AND Employment Tribunal claims against those companies having been received in various Employment Tribunal regions in England and Wales

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the First Schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

All such claims be transferred to the Employment Tribunal at Manchester

AND such claims are to be combined and case managed in accordance with the directions of the Regional Employment Judge at Manchester

AND any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of any such claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge at Manchester (and copied to any other interested party or person)
