Claims against the Respondents having been registered in different regions of the Employment Tribunals in England and Wales.

AND the judgment of London Central Employment Tribunal of the test cases having been made subject to an appeal to the Employment Appeal Tribunal

AND the claims having been stayed pending appeal being sought in the Supreme Court

AND the parties having confirmed that there is no onward appeal to the Supreme Court and having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the first schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:
