AND all other claims being stayed on 09 April 2014 pending the judgment of the Employment Appeal Tribunal

AND the judgment of the Employment Appeal Tribunal having been promulgated on 08 July 2015

AND permission to appeal having been granted by the Court of Appeal on 23 September 2015, to be heard by 03 May 2016

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the first schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. All claims raising the same or similar issues be stayed in their respective regions pending the outcome of Harrod and others v Chief Constable of West Midlands Police and others at the Court of Appeal
2. Any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of these claims should do so upon application to the President.
