## CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims brought against Wm Morrison Supermarkets plc involving multiple equal pay claims relating to Morrisons branded retail stores (Ms A Abdar & Others v Wm Morrison Supermarkets plc) and potentially including claimants employed by Safeway Stores Ltd

CLAIMS against Wm Morrison Supermarkets plc and others as described above having been registered in different regions of the Employment Tribunals in England and Wales and raising the same or similar issues

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013

## IT IS ORDERED THAT

- (1) All such claims in England & Wales raising the same or similar issues shall be transferred to or presented at the Leeds Employment Tribunal for initial case management and possible consolidation in combined proceedings.
- (2) Any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of any such claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge at the Leeds Employment Tribunal (and copied to Leigh Day and Eversheds Sutherland (International) LLP).
