CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims brought against Woolworths plc (in administration) and Entertainment UK involving unfair dismissal, breach of contract and protective awards as a result of failure to consult over a redundancy situation

Claims against the Respondent having been registered in different regions of the Employment Tribunals in England and Wales.


AND all relevant claims having been made subject to an Order for combined proceedings under Rule 10 of Schedule 1 to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2004 and transferred to London Central Employment Tribunal by Direction of the President.

AND those claims having been stayed pending the outcome of Lyttle and others v Bluebird UK Bidco and USDAW v Ethel Austin Ltd (in administration) in the Court of Justice of the European Union by Direction of the President dated 25 February 2014.

AND having now received the Judgment of the CJEU dated 30 April 2015.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The stay be lifted in all claims stayed by the Direction of the President signed 25 February 2014.
2. Any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of these claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge of London Central region.
