

1. On Monday, the 17th day of August 2015, this court committed the following named person to prison

JOHNATHAN HOYLAND

2. in relation to an order dated

5th August 2015

3. which provided that the Respondent/Defendant should not (amongst other things):

- i) cause noise, including raised voices, shouting, swearing and amplified music played at such volume as to be a nuisance to any person residing ... in the locality of 56 Avon Croft, Ossett WF5 8QX

4. The court found that (following admissions made) he had disobeyed/breached that order by:

- i) on the 5th August 2015, shortly after personal service of the order upon him, played amplified music at such volume as to cause a nuisance to Elizabeth Fozzard who lived directly beneath his flat, and
- ii) on the same date and on the same occasion, shouted and swore at Elizabeth Fozzard using abusive and aggressive language such as to cause her distress and anxiety, and constitute a nuisance

5. and imposed the following sentences for those breaches

- i) six weeks imprisonment on each breach, to be served concurrently, suspended for twelve months.

6. Accordingly it was ordered that Johnathan Hoyland be committed for contempt to prison for the total period of six weeks.

The order is suspended until 12.00 noon on 17th August 2016 and will not be put into force if during that time Johnathan Hoyland refrains from further breaches of the said order
