4. the court found that [following admissions made] he had disobeyed/breached that order by

i) On the 4th August 2015 at approximately 11pm there was banging, swearing and shouting and noise of a fight coming from within the Defendant's flat.

ii) On the 5th August 2015 at approximately 10.45pm there was shouting and screaming coming from the defendant's flat.

iii) On the 13th August 2015 at approximately 9.30pm there was shouting and arguing coming from within the defendant's flat.

iv) On the 18th August 2015 at approximately 9.00pm there was shouting, swearing and lots of banging coming from within the defendant's flat.

5. and imposed the following sentence(s) for those breach(es)

i) On the 4 th August 2015 at approximately 11pm there was banging, swearing and shouting and noise of a fight coming from within the Defendant's flat.	i) 2 months imprisonment
ii) On the 5 th August 2015 at approximately 10.45pm there was shouting and screaming coming from the defendant's flat.	ii) 2 months imprisonment
iii) On the 13 th August 2015 at approximately 9.30pm there was shouting and arguing coming from within the defendant's flat.	iii) 2 months imprisonment
iv) On the 18 th August 2015 at approximately 9.00pm there was shouting, swearing and lots of banging coming from within the defendant's flat.	iv) 2 months imprisonment

6. Accordingly it was ordered that⁽²⁾ Kevin Anthony Bailey

be committed for contempt to Her Majesty's Prison at⁽³⁾ HMP Dovegate
for a (total) period of 2 months or until lawfully discharged if sooner, [and
that a warrant of arrest and committal be issued forthwith].
