1. On the 25<sup>th</sup> July 2016 this court committed the following named person to prison

**(2) Patrick McCann**

2. In relation to an order dated

**20<sup>th</sup> April 2016**

3. Which provided that the Defendant should [set out relevant paragraphs of the order]

**i) Obey the injunction dated 20<sup>th</sup> April 2016**

4. The Defendant denied all breaches – the court found following the hearing of oral evidence and cross examination of the complainant that he had targeted the complainant and deliberately disobeyed/breached that order by:

**i) on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016 at approximately 1350hrs, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent was seen on Gorse Drive and/or Captain Fold Road in Little Hulton, both roads from which the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent is prohibited from entering by virtue of paragraph 2 of the Injunction.**

**ii) On 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016 at approximately 1350hrs, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent threatened to shoot Jane Blood and/ or instructed or encouraged Rebecca Kinsella to threaten Jane Blood, thereby engaging in Conduct causing, or likely to cause alarm harassment or distress, conduct from which the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent is prohibited by virtue of paragraph 7 of the Injunction.**

5. And imposed the following sentence(s) for those breach(es)

Breach	Sentence
<b>i) on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016 at approximately 1350hrs, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent was seen on Gorse Drive and/or Captain Fold Road in Little Hulton, both roads from which the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent is prohibited from entering by virtue of paragraph 2 of the Injunction.</b>	26 weeks immediate custodial sentence on each breach (to run concurrently). 6 weeks to be deducted to account for time already served on remand awaiting trial. Total: 20 weeks imprisonment from 25 <sup>th</sup> July 2016
<b>ii) On 20<sup>th</sup> June 2016 at approximately 1350hrs, the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent threatened to shoot Jane Blood and/ or instructed or encouraged Rebecca Kinsella to threaten Jane Blood, thereby engaging in Conduct causing, or likely to cause alarm harassment or distress, conduct from which the 2<sup>nd</sup> Respondent is prohibited by</b>	

virtue of paragraph 7 of the Injunction.

6. Accordingly it was ordered that Patrick McCann be committed for contempt to Her Majesty's Prison at Manchester for a period of 26 weeks immediate custodial sentence on each breach to run concurrently. 6 weeks to be deducted to account for time already served. Total: 20 weeks imprisonment from 25<sup>th</sup> July 2016 or until lawfully discharged if sooner, [and that a warrant of arrest and committal be issued forthwith].
