**ORDER FOR COMMITTAL MADE BY DISTRICT JUDGE COLEMAN ON
11th October 2016 SITTING IN OPEN COURT**

The Parties

1. The applicant is Martina Pearl
The respondent is Samuel Constantinescu

Recitals

2. This is an order for committal to prison.
3. The court held that the respondent Samuel Constantinescu has been guilty of contempt of court in failing to comply with the Occupation Order made at Barnet Family Court on the 15th June 2016
4. The Court found that Samuel Constantinescu has breached the order on 11th and 13th July 2016

UPON hearing oral evidence from the Applicant and the Respondent

AND UPON the Respondent arriving at Court at 10.40 am, having failed to read the notice of hearing directing him to attend Willesden County Court at 10am and therefore being in breach of his bail

AND UPON the Respondent being made aware that he could instruct legal representation and was entitled to apply for legal aid as his liberty was at risk but refusing to do

AND UPON it being noted that the Respondent has previously breached the order and was fined on 30th May 2016 and despite working the fine has not been paid in full

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4. By reason of such contempt the respondent Samuel Constantinescu is committed to H.M. Prison *to be determined by the prison service* for a period of *12 weeks* from the date of his or her arrest, namely 11th October 2016.
5. A warrant for the committal of Samuel Constantinescu shall be issued forthwith by way of execution of the above order.
6. There shall be no order as to costs
