**i) Not to engage in conduct which causes or is capable of causing a nuisance or annoyance or alarm or harassment or distress to any person within the Town of Tewkesbury;**

**ii) Not to threaten to use or use violence against any person within the Town of Tewkesbury;**

**ii) Not to shout at or swear at or use abusive language or make rude or insulting gestures to any person within the Town of Tewkesbury;**

4. the court found that [following admissions made] (s)he had disobeyed/breached that order by

**i) She breached paragraph 1 of the Order at 00.30 hours, again at mid-day and then at about 2.35 in the afternoon, all on 1 July 2017**

**ii) She breached paragraph 2 of the order at the 00.30 hours and then again at mid-day on the same date;**

**iii) She breached paragraph 3 of the order at the same times and on the same dates as in paragraph (i) above**

5. and imposed the following sentence(s) for those breach(es)

6. Accordingly it was ordered that<sup>(2)</sup> SAMANTHA JANE THOMAS

be committed for contempt to Her Majesty's Prison at<sup>(3)</sup> Eastwood Park for a (total) period of 21 days or until lawfully discharged if sooner, [and that a warrant of arrest and committal be issued forthwith].
