



Inquest into the death of Alexander Perepilichnyy

Record of Inquest

Following the inquest hearing at the Central Criminal Court in London held over 12 days between 5th and 23rd June 2017 and 4 days from 10th to 13th April 2018, before the Recorder of London, HHJ Nicholas Hilliard QC, sitting as a Coroner Judge in the coroner's area for Surrey, the following findings and determinations were made:

1. Name of the deceased: **Alexander Vladimirovich Perepilichnyy**

2. Medical cause of death:

1a. Sudden Arrhythmic Death Syndrome

3. How, when and where, and for investigations where section 5(2) of the Coroners and Justice Act 2009 applies, in what circumstances the deceased came by his or her death:

Alexander Perepilichnyy died after collapsing near to Hillcrest Cottage on Granville Road, St George's Hill Estate in Weybridge, Surrey, at about 4.40pm on 10 November 2012 following a cardiac arrhythmia whilst out jogging. Attempts at resuscitation by passers-by and then by paramedics were unsuccessful and Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation was stopped at about 5:37pm.

4. Conclusion of the coroner / jury as to the death: **Natural causes**
