On 18<sup>th</sup> December 2018 the Defendant was prohibited from entering or visiting Adler Court, Chester Green, Derby DE1 3QL. The order was to last until 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2019 and a power of arrest was attached to the order.

The order was served on the Defendant.

On 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019 the Defendant was brought before the court, having been arrested for a reported breach of the injunction in that she had entered or visited Adler Court on 21<sup>st</sup>/22<sup>nd</sup> March 2019.

The Defendant was not represented. The Defendant admitted the breach.

This was the first breach of the injunction.

The court sentenced Dawn Brookes to a suspended committal order of 14 days for contempt of court. The committal order is suspended until noon on 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2019 and will not be put into force if during that time the said Dawn Brookes complies with the terms of the Injunction Order dated 18<sup>th</sup> December 2018.
