In relation to the above numbered case on 5 February 2019, His Honour Judge Rawlings, sitting in The County Court at Birmingham as a Circuit Judge of the County Court, sentenced the Defendant in that case, to a custodial sentence of 12 weeks less 7 days already spent in custody, for contempt of court on breach of Injunction Order dated 15 December 2017. The basis of the sentence imposed is that James Maguire:

Was in breach of the Injunction, by

- 1. On 28 January 2019 at 12.40pm James Maguire (jnr) breached Terms 2 of the Final Injunction dated 15 December 2017 by begging in Birmingham by means of words, or conduct or position and approached another person asking for money.
- 1. 12 weeks in prison the time spent on remand being 7 days, do count towards the term.
 - 1. 11 weeks.
