On 5 April 2019 District Judge Jarzabkowski sitting at the County Court at Brentford sentenced Mr Otis Noel to 1 consecutive term and 2 concurrent terms of imprisonment of 28 weeks for contempt of Court for Breach of an Order made on 1 February 2019 under Section 1 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 in that amongst other things his actions harassment, alarm and distress to other inhabitants of the London Borough of Ealing.
