

**Pursuant to paragraph 13 of Practice Direction: Committal for Contempt of Court
– Open Court**

Case Number D02BM967 Birmingham City Council v Mr Simon Davies

In relation to the above numbered case Her Honor Judge Carmel Wall sitting in the County Court at Birmingham as a Judge of the County Court, sentenced the Defendant Mr. Simon Davies in that case, to a custodial sentence of Weeks s for contempt of court on breach of an Injunction Order dated The basis of the sentence imposed is that

- Was in breach of the Injunction by
 1. 29 June 2019 causing alarm or distress to another person by having with you drug paraphernalia in breach of paragraph 4
 2. 4 July 2019 begging by asking the public for spare change in breach of paragraph 2
 3. On 1st July 2019 causing alarm or distress to a street warden by making remarks which he overheard causing him to feel distress.
 4. On 3rd July 2019 by begging in breach of paragraph 2

All 6 Weeks imprisonment All concurrent but suspended for the duration of the injunction order on the terms sent out on page 1

The order is suspended until 4pm 14 December 2019 and will not be put in force if during that time the contemnor Simon Davies complies with the terms of the injunction and

- 1. Comply with the injunction of 15 December 2017 until its expiry**
- 2. Must keep appointments made with you by William Booth and Shelter**
- 3. Must Co-Operate with William Booth and Shelter in applying for Social Security Benefits and in obtaining accommodation**
