1. On this court committed the following named person to prison

<sup>(2)</sup> **John Turner**

2. In relation to an order dated

**27 October 2017**

3. which provided that the Defendant should not

1. Engaging or threatening to engage in conduct which is capable of causing a nuisance or annoyance to:
  - (i) any person with a right to occupy housing accommodation in the neighbourhood of Convent Close, Leyland, Lancashire, PR25 4PW;
  - (ii) any person visiting such accommodation in the neighbourhood of Convent Close, Leyland, Lancashire, PR25 4PW;
  - (iii) any person engaged in lawful activity in the neighbourhood of Convent Close, Leyland, Lancashire, PR25 4PW;
  - (iv) any person employed in connection with the exercise of the Applicant's housing management functions this includes but is not limited to contractors and sub-contractors employed on behalf of the Applicant;
2. Harassing any such person as referred to in paragraphs 1(i-iv) above;
3. Using abusive or insulting or threatening behaviour against any such person as referred to in paragraphs 1(i-iv) above;

Using or threatening violence against any such person as referred to in paragraphs 1(i-iv) above.

4. the court found that he had breached that order by

1. On 13 September 2018, while on the telephone to an employee of South Ribble Council, namely Andrew Howard, the respondent engaged in threatening behaviour towards a neighbouring resident, becoming aggressive and stating "I will go and sort this out myself."
2. On 5 October 2018 the respondent engaged in aggressive behaviour towards his neighbour, Ms Sally Whaite. The respondent started banging loudly on the walls and then banged loudly on the front door of 1 Convent Close. When Ms Whaite opened the door the respondent shouted "Stop the banging," and "I don't give a damn." When told that it was Ms Whaite's one year old disabled

son who was responsible for the banging, the respondent shouted, "I will get you evicted, bitch." The respondent's behaviour was intimidating and aggressive and caused Ms Whaite to fear that she was about to be assaulted.

3. On 5 October 2018 the respondent behaving aggressively towards police officers who attended his property by exploding into a torrent of abuse and shouting "all police are corrupt."
4. On 10 October 2018 while on the telephone to an employee of South Ribble Council, namely Andrew Howard, the respondent referred to neighbours namely Ms Whaite and her partner Mr Minuti as "fucking animals" and said "if things carry on the way they are, that child will not make adulthood", causing Mr Howard to believe that the respondent threatened harm to Ms Whaite's one year old child.
5. On 16 October 2018 the respondent caused nuisance and annoyance, alarm and distress to Mr Minuti and Ms Whaite, by shouting on the telephone to a third party so that it was audible to them in their adjoining premises, "If you're not prepared to stop it, you're on notice now that I'll go and sort them out." The respondent repeated the reference to "sorting out" his neighbours. The respondent then shouted, "I'll deal with it my way, and when I end up in Court ... go and fuck yourself."
6. On 21 December 2018 the respondent referred to Mr Richard Newman, an officer of the applicant who attended at his premises to serve an injunction order and other documents as a "little prick". The respondent then threw the documents out of the lounge window. He then pushed the documents back out through the letterbox after Mr Newman attempted to deliver them again and shouted, "Go on, do one you fucking idiot."

5. and imposed the following sentence for that breach

Breach	Sentence
On each breach set out above.	14 days imprisonment on each breach, to be served concurrently, suspended for a period of 2 years
