

Pursuant to paragraph 13 of Practice Direction: Committal for Contempt of Court – Open Court

In the County Court sitting at Burnley on 13 November 2019

In the matter of Together Housing Association Limited -v- Colette Walsh and anr – case number F00ZP667

District Judge Clarke sentenced Colette Walsh to a committal order for contempt of court. The basis of that sentence was that Colette Walsh admitted breaching an order made by the court on 9 July 2019 pursuant to Section 1 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014. The breaches admitted and sentences imposed were as follows:

1. Entering 1 Silverdale Close, Blackburn on 12 November 2019, in breach of paragraph 1(1) of the injunction order – a sentence of 28 days was imposed.

The court directed that the sentence should run concurrently with sentences imposed by the court on 28 September 2019, which sentences had been suspended and were now activated. Accordingly it was ordered that Colette Walsh be committed for contempt to prison for a total period of 28 days.
