### IN THE COUNTY COURT Sitting at Bradford

1. On the 4 March 2020 this court committed the following named person to prison

2. In relation to an order dated

**11 November 2019 (as amended 6 December 2019)**

3. which provided that the Respondent/ Defendant should not [set out relevant paras of the order]

- i) **That Janet Plester must not (whether by encouraging, permitting or inciting any other person):**
- 1. Use of threaten to use violence against Clare Ford of 11 Dean Road Odsal or Ann Brankin of 45 Elmsfield Drive Odsal**
  - 2. Engage in conduct capable of causing harassment alarm or distress to any person, including using abusive, racist or foul language**

4. the court found that following admissions made she had disobeyed/breached that order by

- i) **On 4 December 2019 at approximately 22.00 the Defendant was inside her property at 9 Dean Road, Odsal, Bradford ('the property') using abusive, racist or foul language when she was shouting the words *black bastard*" and "*fuck the Order*" through the walls of the property in a manner so as to cause harassment, alarm or distress to the occupants of the adjoin property, Clare ford and Dominic Sleightholme.**
- ii) **On 5 December 2019 at approximately 08.10 the Defendant was standing in the front garden of the property when she threatened violence towards Clare ford and Dominic Sleightholme. The Defendant shouted the words "*I'll smash your faces in*".**
- iii) **On 5 December 2019 at approximately 08.10 the Defendant was standing in the front garden of the Property using abusive, racist or foul language towards Dominic Sleightholme. The Defendant shouted the words "*you black bastard*" in a manner so as to cause harassment, alarm or distress to Clare Ford and Dominic Sleightholme.**
- iv) **On 16 December 2019 at approximately 21.30 the Defendant was standing in the doorway of the property when she used abusive, racist or foul language towards Dominic Sleightholme. The Defendant**

shouted the words ***“you black bastard”*** in a manner so as to cause harassment, alarm or distress to Dominic Sleightholme.

v) On 19 December 2019 at approximately 23.00 the Defendant was inside the property when using abusive, racist or foul language towards Clare Ford and Dominic Sleightholme. The Defendant shouted the words ***“I’ll get you back you bastards and “you black bastard”*** in a manner so as to cause harassment, alarm or distress to Clare Ford and Dominic Sleightholme.

5. and imposed the following sentence(s) for those breach(es)

breach i)-iii)	Sentence i) <b>Two months immediate custodial sentence on each breach to run concurrently with each other</b>
iv-v)	ii) <b>Four months immediate custody on each breach to run concurrently with each other but consecutive to breaches i)-iii)</b>

6. Accordingly it was ordered that<sup>(2)</sup>

be committed for contempt to Her Majesty’s Prison at<sup>(2)</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ for a (total) period of \_\_\_\_\_ or until lawfully discharged if sooner, [and that a warrant of arrest and committal be issued forthwith].
