PILOT PRACTICE DIRECTION: THE USE OF FORMER SALARIED JUDGES

- 1. On 19 March 2020, I issued a pilot practice direction on panel composition in the First-tier and Upper Tribunals.
- 2. I have decided to issue this further practice direction, also on a pilot basis, to provide clarification on the status of former salaried judges. It is issued for a period of six months, although it may be reviewed within that period should it become inappropriate or unnecessary and may be revoked at any time.
- 3. Former salaried judges are to be interpreted as falling within the definition of salaried judges for the purposes of the <u>Pilot Practice Direction: Contingency Arrangements in the First-tier and Upper Tribunals.</u>
