and the Defendant having admitted the allegations the court released the Defendant on bail and listed a sentencing hearing.

4. On 27<sup>th</sup> July the Court and the Court imposed the following sentences for those breaches

1	28 days imprisonment suspended for one year on compliance with

2	28 days imprisonment (concurrent) suspended for one year on
