Dear Assistant Coroner

I have been asked to convey the response of our Area Highway Manager to your Regulation 28 Report on the death of Mitica Mihaita Ladunca. Thank you for sending this to us.

The Inquest had heard from [REDACTED] a Collision Investigator for Surrey Police, that the crossing across the carriageway is uncontrolled and that there is no signage warning drivers that pedestrians may be attempting to cross the road in either direction. You stated that while the absence of signage did not contribute to the particular circumstances of Mr Ladunca’s death, you were concerned that it may give rise to a risk of future deaths.

In light of your report the Area Highway Manager has reviewed the location and while it is clear that your findings are that lack of signage did not contribute to this fatality he will install advance signage at this location. He is pleased to confirm that this work will go ahead on 29/30 September. This will be coordinated with the County’s high speed Traffic Management programme.
