Message on behalf of LTA Communications:

Illegal Flights

In response to and following a coroner's inquest into the circumstances surrounding the death of professional footballer, Emiliano Sala, the coroner has asked for the LTA to cascade information to all players in relation to commercial flights from unlicensed operators. This means you should consider the following if a passenger in an aircraft other than a scheduled airliner:

All flights are required to meet certain standards, and the organisation or individual operating the flight must have the correct certificate, insurance and licenses. Commercial flights which are unlicensed and operate without the required authorisations, certifications or permissions in place are illegal, and have significant risks associated with them, including risk of fatality.
