ANONYMITY ORDER

BEFORE Mathew Gullick QC, sitting as a Deputy High Court Judge in the Queen's Bench Division,

UPON hearing David Sanderson of Counsel for the Claimants and Andrew Lewis QC Leading Counsel for the Defendants,

AND UPON the court being satisfied that an order in the terms of paragraphs 1 to 4 below is necessary to protect the interests of the Claimant and that there is no countervailing public interest in disclosure,

IT IS ORDERED that:-

1. Hereafter, in these proceedings
 - a. the Claimant shall be referred to as LM;
 - b. the litigation friend shall be referred to as NP.

2. Pursuant to CPR Rule 39.2 (4) there shall not be disclosed in any report of these proceedings the names or addresses of the parties listed in paragraph 1 of this order nor any details leading to their identification and, if referred to, they shall be identified by initials as set out in paragraph 1.

3. Pursuant to CPR Rule 5.4C, a person who is not party to the proceedings may obtain a copy of the Statement of Case, Judgment or Order from the Court records only if the Statement of Case, Judgment or Order has been anonymised such that parties listed in paragraph 1 of this order are identified by initials as set out in that paragraph and the address of each of them has been deleted from the documents.

4. There shall be permission to apply in respect of this Order.
