**ORDER**

**UPON** the Claimant's application for anonymity to protect her interests

**UPON** the Court being satisfied pursuant to CPR r. 39.2(4) that non-disclosure of the identity of the Claimant is necessary in order to protect the interests of the Claimant and there is no sufficient countervailing public interest in disclosure

**AND PURSUANT TO** section 11 of the Contempt of Court Act 1981, section 6 of the Human Rights Act 1998 and CPR Rule 5.4A to 5.4D and CPR Rule 39.2:

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The identity of the Claimant shall not be disclosed.
2. The Claimant and her parents shall hereinafter be referred to in these proceedings respectively as 'LXP' (Claimant) and 'JYP' (Mother and Litigation Friend) and 'JZP' (Father).
3. There shall not be disclosed in any report of the proceedings the names or address of the Claimant or her litigation friend or father or any details

leading to the identification of the Claimant or her parents and if referred to, they shall only be referred to as 'LXP' and 'JYP' and 'JZP'.

4. The address of the Claimant be stated in all statements of case and other documents to be filed or served in the proceedings as the address of the Claimant's solicitors.
5. Pursuant to CPR Rule 5.4C a person who is not a party to the proceedings may obtain a copy of a Statement of Case, judgment or order from the court records only with the permission of a Master and only if the statement of case, judgment or order has been anonymised such that:-
  - (a) The Claimant and her parents are referred to only as, "LXP' and 'JYP' and 'JZP'.
  - (b) The address of the Claimant has been deleted from those documents.
  - (c) There has been redacted any information which might identify the Claimant or her parents.

Any such application for permission must be made on notice to the Claimant, and the Court will effect service.

6. There shall be no publication in any newspaper or other media or other disclosure of any name, address, picture or information tending to identify the Claimant or her parents.
7. Any non-party affected by this Order may apply on notice to all parties to have this Order set aside or varied.
8. Costs in the case.
