## **ORDER FOR ANONYMITY**

BEFORE Her Honour Judge Walden-Smith Sitting as a Judge of the High Court sitting at the Royal Courts of Justice on 20 May 2021 at a hearing heard remotely

**AND UPON HEARING** Lizanne Gumbel one of Her Majesty's Counsel, on behalf of the Claimant and Claire Toogood, one of Her Majesty's Counsel, on behalf of the Defendant

AND UPON consideration of the Claimant's Article 8 right to respect for private and family life and the Article 10 right to freedom of expression.

AND UPON the Court being satisfied that non-disclosure of the identity of the Claimant and Litigation Friend is necessary to secure the proper administration of justice and in order to protect the interests of the Claimant

AND PURSUANT to rule 39.2(4) of the Civil Procedure Rules and section II of the Contempt of Court Act 1981 and rules 5.4C and 5.4D of the Civil Procedure Rules.

# IT IS ORDERED that:-

1. Publication or disclosure of the identity of the Claimant and of the litigation friend is prohibited.

- 2. In any judgment or order in the proceedings, in any documents subsequently disclosed from the Court File to non- parties and in any report of the proceedings by the press or otherwise, the individuals names shall be substituted by letters as follows:
  - a) The Claimant shall be referred to as LLS;
  - b) The litigation friend shall be referred to as ABM.
- 3. The file is to be retained by the Court and marked "Anonymised".
- 4. Non-parties may not inspect or obtain a copy of any document on or from the Court file (other than this order duly anonymised as directed) without the permission of the Court. Any application for such permission must be made on at least 7 days' notice to the Claimant, and the Court will effect service.
- 5. Non- parties shall not have access to the documents on the court file other than those which have been anonymised so as to prevent identification as set out above.
- 6. A copy of this order shall not be published on the website of the Judiciary of England and Wales.
- 7. Any non-party affected by this Order may apply on notice to all parties to have this Order set aside or varied.
- 8. Costs in the case.
