3	INVESTIGATION and INQUEST
	On 22/06/2022 an investigation was commenced into the death of Ami Louise Mitchell. The investigation concluded at the end of the inquest on 3 rd November 2022. The conclusion of the inquest was Suicide.
4	CIRCUMSTANCES OF THE DEATH
	See below
5	CORONER'S CONCERNS
	During the course of the inquest the evidence revealed matters giving rise to concern. In my opinion there is a risk that future deaths will occur unless action is taken. In the circumstances it is my statutory duty to report to you.
	The MATTERS OF CONCERN are as follows
	Ms. Mitchell was under the care of AWP Trust with suicidal ideation from March to May 2022 until she hung herself on 31 st May 2022.
	Throughout this period she presented regularly and persistently with a) delusions;
	b) auditory hallucinations (including command);
	c) visual hallucinations; d) intrusive thoughts of killing her partner and children; e) her and her family requesting admission

Despite this a) No formal diagnosis was made;

b) No escalation in management or admission took place.
