- i. Breached para 8 of the order dated 20th September 2019 on 14th February 2020
- j. Breached para 4 of the order dated 20th September 2019 on 14th February 2020
- k. Breached para 3 of the order dated 10th March 2020 on 20th October 2021
- l. Breached para 2(b) of the order dated 10th March 2020 between 11th October 2021 and 8th November 2021

- m. Breached para 3(a) of the order dated 10th March 2020 between 11th October 2021 and 8th November 2021
- n. Breached paras 3(a) and (b) of the order dated 10th March 2020 on 13th November 2021
