CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims against Rutherford Health PLC (in Compulsory Liquidation), Rutherford Cancer Care Limited (in Compulsory Liquidation) and/or Rutherford Diagnostics Limited (in Compulsory Liquidation) arising out of their having been placed into compulsory liquidation by Court Order on 13 June 2022

CLAIMS seeking a protective award against Rutherford Health PLC (in Compulsory Liquidation), Rutherford Cancer Care Limited (in Compulsory Liquidation) and/or Rutherford Diagnostics Limited (in Compulsory Liquidation) arising out of their having been placed into compulsory liquidation by Court Order on 13 June 2022 having been received in various Employment Tribunal regions in England and Wales,

AND having regard to the overriding objective under rule 2 of the First Schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013,

AND having regard to the distribution of judicial and administrative workload and resources as between the Employment Tribunal regions in England and Wales,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

ALL such present and future claims be transferred to the North East region of the Employment Tribunals;

AND such claims are to be combined and case managed in accordance with the directions of the Regional Employment Judge for the that region, or such other Employment Judge appointed by him, with a view to any claims being heard at the Employment Tribunal in Newcastle whether in person, remotely or by a combination;

AND any party or representative wishing to make representations about the future conduct of any such claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge for the North East region, and copy any such representations to any other interested party or person;
