Statement of Reasons

These proposals are intended to remove the inconsiderate parking that occurs around the school pedestrian and vehicular entrances onto Waterside Drive. Following the unfortunate fatality that occurred last year the police report indicated that additional measures needed to be looked at to create better pedestrian visibility and reduce the vehicle/pedestrian conflict that could occur.

By proposing these proposals, it will improve road safety outside Newstead Academy and long Waterside Drive within the vicinity of the school entrances.
