## SEVENTH ADDENDUM TO PRESIDENTIAL GUIDANCE ORIGINALLY ISSUED ON 5 SEPTEMBER 2017

- 1. This Seventh Addendum updates, but does not otherwise replace, the <a href="Presidential Guidance">Presidential Guidance</a> originally issued on 5 September 2017 and the <a href="First">First</a>, <a href="Second">Second</a>, <a href="Third">Third</a>, <a href="Fourth">Fourth</a>, <a href="Fifth">Fifth</a> and <a href="Sixth">Sixth</a> Addenda subsequently issued on 23 March 2018, 25 March 2019, 27 March 2020, 26 March 2021, 28 March 2022 and 24 March 2023, which remain relevant to claims presented before 6 April 2024. The Seventh Addendum takes into account changes in the <a href="RPI All Items">RPI All Items</a> Index released on 20 March 2024\*.
- 2. In respect of claims presented on or after 6 April 2024, the "Vento bands" shall be as follows: a lower band of £1,200 to £11,700 (less serious cases); a middle band of £11,700 to £35,200 (cases that do not merit an award in the upper band); and an upper band of £35,200 to £58,700 (the most serious cases), with the most exceptional cases capable of exceeding £58,700.
- In respect of claims presented in Scotland, the bands remain subject to paragraph 12 of the original Presidential Guidance.
