ORDER

UPON the handing down electronically of the judgment following the trial of the liability issues (the 'Liability Judgment')

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The decision hearing relating to the Liability Judgment (the 'Decision Hearing'), including any consequential matters such as any application for permission to appeal and costs, is adjourned to the first available date after 5 December 2023 with a time estimate of half a day. For the avoidance of doubt, this is an adjournment within paragraph 4.1(a) of Practice Direction 52A to Part 52.
- 2. The parties shall inform the Court as soon as practicable and, in any event, 7 days before the date of the Decision Hearing if they consider that the time estimate should be varied.
- 3. The parties shall cooperate to agree the form of order consequential upon the Liability Judgment.

- 4. Insofar as the form of order consequential upon the Liability Judgment cannot be agreed between the parties:
 - a. any application consequential on the Liability Judgment, shall be made by 24 November 2023.
 - b. On the date referred to in paragraph 4(a), the parties shall file a draft of the order to be made showing any matters which are agreed and, in the case of any matters which are not agreed, the parties' respective rival forms of order in those respects.
 - c. The parties shall file and exchange skeleton arguments 3 days before the date on which the Decision Hearing is listed.
- 5. The time for filing any Appellant's Notice under CPR 52.12(2) shall be extended to 21 days after (i) the date on which the Decision Hearing is listed or (ii) the date of the grant or refusal of any application made pursuant to paragraph 4(a) for permission to appeal, whichever is later.
- 6. Liberty to apply.
- 7. The Claimant shall serve this Order on the Defendants.
- 8. Costs in the case.
