1. On 21<sup>st</sup> March 2024 this court committed the following named person to prison

Steven McDaid

2. In relation to an order dated

15<sup>th</sup> December 2023

3. which provided that the Respondent/ Defendant should not

Engage "in conduct causing or capable of causing harassment, alarm or distress towards any person who resides, visits or engages in lawful activity at Burton Court, Summer Road, Thames Ditton, KT7 0QF, or towards the claimant's staff, agents or contractors."

4. The court found that he had breached that order by

On 20<sup>th</sup> February 2024, ripping Mr Christopher Fell's CCTV camera off the wall, throwing it to the ground and destroying it which caused and was capable of causing distress to Mr Fell in breach of paragraph 2 of the Injunction of 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023.

5. and imposed the following sentences for those breaches

28 days imprisonment.

6. Accordingly it was ordered that **STEVEN MCDAID** be committed for contempt to prison for a total period of 28 days.

The order is suspended until 4pm on 16<sup>th</sup> December 2024 and will not be put into force if during that time **STEVEN MCDAID** complies with the following terms:

- a) The terms of the Injunction Order dated 15<sup>th</sup> December 2023, and any amendments thereto, which Injunction remains in full force and effect.  
b) The Defendant must not go to or enter or attempt to enter Burton Court, Summer Road, Thames Ditton, KT7 0QF, save with the prior written agreement of the Claimant and provided that the Defendant is accompanied by an officer of the Claimant or a Police Officer.
