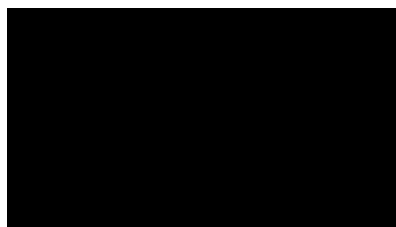
Thank you for your letter of 4 November about mandatory distance regulations for parking.

I should note that there is no specific statutory guidance or mandatory distance regulations that stipulate the minimum distance single yellow lines must be situated from a junction.

Ultimately, it is for the local authority to assess that the visibility of the junction is sufficient and to determine how much they want to protect with yellow lines.

As you may be aware, traffic signing is now devolved and would be a matter for the Welsh Government.
