

JUJHAR SINGH SAHOTA & ANOR

v.

DOROTA KAZIMIERA NEWMAN

Committal for Contempt of Court in Open Court at the High Court of Justice (Chancery Division)

Pursuant to paragraph 13 of the Practice Direction: Committal for Contempt of Court – Open Court dated 26 March 2015

In relation to Claim No. BL-2024-001468 on 2 December 2025 at the Royal Courts of Justice in London Mr Justice Adam Johnson sentenced Ms Dorota Kazimiera Newman to a sentence of 12 months imprisonment for contempt of Court. The basis of the sentence was Ms Newman's contempt in failing to provide information as to all her assets in England & Wales having a value in excess of £1,000, confirmed on Affidavit, as required under paragraphs 8(1) and 9 of the Order made by Mr Justice Miles herein dated 21 March 2025.

The Court also made a costs Order against Ms Newman, requiring her to pay the Claimants' costs of the contempt application on the indemnity basis, summarily assessed in the amount of £26,291.50.
