UPON hearing from Mr Ben Joyes, counsel for the Appellant, and Ms Amanda Bostock, counsel for the Respondent

AND FOR THE REASONS set out in the judgment handed down herewith

**IT IS ORDERED** that:

1. The provisions of the Sexual Offences (Amendment) Act 1992 apply to this case. Under those provisions, where a sexual offence has been committed against a person, no matter relating to that person shall during that person's lifetime be included in any publication if it is likely to lead members of the public to identify that person as the complainant of that offence. The appellant's name has thus been replaced by the cipher "GRT". This prohibition applies unless waived or lifted in accordance with section 3 of the Act.

2. The appeal be dismissed.
3. The applications to rely upon fresh evidence are refused.
4. There be no order for costs.
5. The Appellant's publicly funded costs be subject to detailed assessment.
